



Edmund Rice College in Bindoon is an agricultural college situated on 3500ha of farmland in the Shire of Chittering. The College is a small rural day and boarding school catering for up to 150 students from years 7 – 12 and approximately 45 minutes from Midland and Joondalup. The College requires:

Residential Supervisors (Part time and Full time)

The College requires full time and part-time Residential Supervisors for our Boarding Houses to commence as soon as possible. Applicants must be available to work weekends during term time.

Ideally, we are seeking energetic and out-going persons who can engage with teenagers living away from home. The successful applicant will be:

- Caring, energetic and innovative
- Able to communicate effectively with male and female teenagers and staff
- Involved with other staff in the daily operation of the boarding houses
- Engaged in co-curricular activities
- Qualified in water safety or higher or be willing to undertake suitable training
- An understanding of the cultural needs of Aboriginal students

Highly desirable skills but not essential include:

- Experience in residential care
- A bus license will be an advantage.

Applicants must be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic Education. A Working with Children Card and NCCHC screening is a prerequisite to appointment.
